Vaccines/Immunizations

Children and adults with Insurance or Point of Sale (POS) Cash/Check/Credit Card

We offer all the childhood immunizations from infant through high school and college prep to kids who are covered by most major medical insurance such as Blue Cross (Anthem), Cigna, Golden Rule, Sagamore, United Healthcare and professional Benefit Administrators. There are many other providers on the list as well. We accept Medicare B for flu and pneumonia (Pneumovax and Prevnar).

For Adults 19 and over we offer a full range of vaccines for those with insurance (same as above) and POS, including Hep A & B, Tdap, Flu and HPV. We also have vaccines for those who have no insurance or whose insurance does not pay for vaccines (travel vaccines are not included)

We are a Certified Travel Clinic and offer vaccines such as Typhoid and Yellow Fever (including the Yellow Fever Certificate), Hepatitis A and B.

Prices on the POS vaccines are:

Hep A \$70 each (series of 2)	Tdap \$40
Hep B \$60 each (series of 3)	TB skin test (PPD) \$20 includes copy of report
Rabies (to be determined – TBD) – special order	Typhoid \$100
Yellow Fever \$150 – currently unavailable	Zostavax (Shingles) \$225

Clinton County Immunization Clinic (CCIC) – is available for children 6 weeks up to their 19th birthday who are covered by Medicaid or have no insurance coverage. Located on the third floor of IU Frankfort Hospital on South Jackson Street. Hours: Tuesday's and Thursday's from 10:30 to 5:30. Appointment is necessary. Bring your child's immunization record and Medicaid card, if applicable.

Other services offered:

Lead Testing and lead poisoning investigation.

Investigation of communicable/reportable diseases in Clinton County (TB, Hepatitis, STD's, and animal bites.

Case Manager of Tuberculosis.

STD Clinic – confidential testing and treatment services for chlamydia and gonorrhea. By appointment, please. Test results typically in one week. One-time fee of \$10.

Referrals for free testing for Hepatitis B & C and HIV.
